Anatomical Waste Disposal for the 14th Floor

Principle of the Protocol

Animal anatomical waste needs to be disposed of in red pails in order to prevent the unwanted microbial growth/spread in the laboratory environment. All biohazard/chemical, contaminated with toxins, cytotoxic and non-contaminated anatomical waste needs to be disposed of in red pails.

Materials

- Red animal anatomical waste pail, located in cold room 1451A
- Zip-lock bags or biobags provided by DCM

Procedures

- 1. Waste pick-up is scheduled weekly on Mondays. Environmental Protection Service (EPS) needs to be informed in advance for the pick-up of waste and the drop-off of new pails.
- 2. Place the anatomical waste in a zip-lock bag or biobag.
- 3. In order to prevent unwanted smell in the cold room, freeze the tissue prior to disposal, and only place in the red pail the day before or day of the pickup.
- 4. Seal the lid and label it "Full"
- 5. Contact the EPS Service Line at EPS Service Line 416-946-3473 to inform them of the full bucket and to request new buckets if necessary.
